- A. Interview of Grace Kho for Appointment to the Youth Commission -
Term Ending: 4/30/15

The Board reviewed Grace's resume and discussed her interest in serving on the Youth Commission.

Ms. Jordan said one of the things that could be helpful that people may not be aware of would be programs that are available at the county or state level such as locations for latex paint recycling. She would like to bring more awareness to programs that are already in place.

Trustee LaBedz asked Ms. Jordan if there is something that she currently practices at home that is not widespread in the community. Ms. Jordan mentioned recycling by private industry such as grocery stores where plastic bags can be recycled. She is not sure if people are aware they can also recycle other plastic bags such as plastic zip bags and bread bags at grocery stores. Following discussion,
