Tree Lighting Event

Trolleys will arrive on site at 4 p.m. and will travel on a loop from North School Park to the Museum to Harmony Park, 4 – 7 p.m.

Commissioner Seifert said he has the ice carver and a photographer at Harmony Park from 4:30 – 7:30 p.m. The ice carver will create three sculptures that will remain in the park. The photographer will take free holiday portraits at the fountain area.

Chairman Laurie Mitchell has arranged for Metropolis cast members to staff the trolleys as hosts who will let riders know what activities will occur at each stop.
