I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Arlington Heights Youth Commission was called to order by Chair Spicer at 6:07pm at the Arlington Heights Memorial Library.

IV. REPORTS

Park District – Commissioner Healy shared information about the upcoming Trunk or Treat at Public Works on Monday, October 30, 2017 from 3:00pm-5:00pm.

School District –

Arlington Heights Memorial Library – Chair Spicer reported on library activities.

Police Department – Officer Hamrick said that “Brave Challenge” would be held at 3:15pm on November 1 at Thomas Middle School. He said Trick or Treat in downtown Arlington Heights was Monday, October 30th from 3:00pm-5:00pm.

Commissioners at Large – The Youth Commissioners gave updates on activities at their school and discussed interest in the Harper Promise Program.

V. OLD BUSINESS

Teen Snow Shoveling Program, “Let it Snow, Make it Go” – The Commissioners discussed creating posters of the brochure, creating a video, and getting the information out in the schools.

Teen Movie Night – Katie Waszak from the Arlington Heights Park District gave the Commission an overview of how a movie night works with the Park District. After discussion, it was decided to hold the Teen Movie Night at Rec Park sometime in June or July with an 8:45pm start. The Commissioners also discussed options for activities for teens prior to the movie being shown including having the Teen Battle of the Bands winner perform, having a Spike Ball contest, and possibly having the Rec Park swimming pool only open to teen uses that evening.

Teen Job Fair – It was decided that the 2018 Teen Job Fair would be held on Tuesday, February 6, 2018 at the Arlington Heights Memorial Library. Earlier in the evening of the Teen Job Fair, the Library will provide two programs for teens - “How to Prepare for an Interview” and “How to Prepare a Resume”.
