I. CALL TO ORDER

III. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

A motion was made by Commissioner Guerra to approve the August 20 2015 minutes and seconded by Commissioner Kho. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

IV. REPORTS

Park District – No Report

School District –Chair Dyer stated that the Girls Basketball Tournament with the Police Department will be held at South Middle School tomorrow evening.

Arlington Heights Memorial Library – Commissioner Spicer said that in October they will be starting a “Peer Study Lab”. Students who have a B or better average and want to earn volunteer hours by helping other kids out in a certain subject can serve on Wednesdays from 7:00pm-9:00pm and Sundays from 3:00pm-5:00pm. It will be an open lab where students help each other. Commissioner Spicer said he will track the volunteer hours.

Police Department – Officer Hamrick said he is working on a fundraiser with District 25 and the 7th and 8th Grade Girls Basketball Tournament at South Middle School, Thomas Middle School, and a Middle School from Bolingbrook that benefits Special Olympics. The Police Department works closely with Special Olympics and invited four Special Olympic athletes to the event at South Middle School tomorrow. They will promote Special Olympics, talk about the events that they participate in, and watch the basketball games. He mentioned that volunteers were needed.
