CALL TO ORDER:

A quorum being present, P. Szabo called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

M. Polonsky moved for the approval of the Minutes of the Bicycle Advisory Commission Meeting July 21, 2014. A. Medsker seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:

P. Szabo recapped the ride along Bike Audit with CMAP. M. Walczak, M. Polonsky, and himself attended and represented BPAC. B. Schwab and Tiffany Schmoker from the Engineering Department rode along to represent the Village. Berenice Vallecillos, John O'Neal, and Trevor Dick rode along to represent CMAP. The ride was put together by P. Szabo and highlighted the positive elements of the Village's bikeways systems and end ride locations and it also highlights areas of need and opportunities. For example, the need for access to Busse Woods along Arlington Heights Road and crossing of major arterial road such as Palatine Road and Lake Cook Road to name a few.

P. Szabo would like to have the next bikeways map updated with Pace Bus stops as well as major employment centers. In addition to that improvement, he requested that BPAC members bring their top projects they would like to see done.

P. Szabo reported on the Active Transportation Council Formation and informed the BPAC he would be reaching out to the surrounding communities and asking them to participate in this task force for improved regional bicycling. He asked which communities should be included and BPAC members came up with the following list: Buffalo Grove, Palatine, Mount Prospect,

Wheeling, Rolling Meadows, Elk Grove, Prospect Heights, Des Plaines, Hoffman Estates, Barrington, and Schaumburg.

P. Szabo announced to the BPAC that J. Harlow sent an e-mail indicating that she needed to resign from the BPAC due to a change in her job.

OLD BUSINESS:

- B. Schwab stated that the Village provided all the GIS data that was requested by CMAP and that they have started setting up Key Person Interviews which are being held at Village Hall starting this week.

NEW BUSINESS:

B. Schwab informed the BPAC that she was just informed that a representative from the Police Department was assigned to start attending the BPAC meetings.

A. Medsker inquired about the representative that was supposed to participating from the Arlington Heights Park District, but B. Schwab was unsure of who that person is
