SUBJECT: Liquor License Interview: Passero, LLC, dba Passero

At the Committee-of-the-Whole meeting on September 5, 2017, Rikki and Scott Peota, representatives of Passero, LLC, dba Passero, located at 5 West Campbell, will be interviewed for consideration of a full service "Class "A" liquor license.

Liquor Classification:	Class "A" license permits the retail sale, in restaurants only, of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises where sold and have a seating capacity at tables for a minimum of 25 persons for food service.
Establishment Liquor Hours:	Closed Mondays. Tues thru Thurs: 11 AM – 10 PM Fri & Sat: 11 AM – 11 PM Sun: 11 AM – 8 PM
Lease or Ownership:	Leased through May 2, 2020
Basset Certification:	Scheduled
Establishment Violations:	None
Applicant Liquor Related Sales Violations:	None

On July 27, 2017 the Arlington Heights Police Department completed a background check on Rikki Peota, who has 85% ownership of the restaurant. No convictions were disclosed and no criminal derogatory information was found. In addition, no lawsuits, judgments, or liens were outstanding. Ms. Peota will complete Basset training by the end of September.

On August 10, 2017 the Arlington Heights Police Department completed a background check on Scott Peota, who has 15% ownership of the restaurant. No

convictions were disclosed and no criminal derogatory information was found. Mr. Peota will complete Basset training by the end of September.

A walk-thru of the restaurant will be conducted once the tables and chairs have been installed. The liquor license will be not issued until the walk-thru is completed and the floor plan is consistent with the submitted plan.

Upon a satisfactory liquor interview, it would be appropriate to approve the issuance of a Class "A" liquor license to Passero, LLC dba Passero, located at 5 West Campbell.
