Item: Consideration of a Liquor License - Gumrai Thai

Department: Village Manager's Office

Representatives of Triple 8, Corp. dba Gumrai Thai Restaurant will be interviewed for consideration of a beer and wine Class "E" liquor license. This is the result of a change in ownership of Gumrai Thai.

Liquor Classification:	Class "E" license permits the sale of beer and wine only for consumption in restaurants that have a seating capacity at tables for a minimum of 25 persons for food service.
Establishment Liquor Hours:	Mon - Thurs: 11am - 9pm; Fri - Sat: 11am - 10pm; Sun: 12pm - 9pm
Lease or Ownership:	Leased until August 2024
Basset Certification:	Yes
Establishment Violations:	August 2008 by previous owner
Applicant Liquor Violations:	None

On August 14, 2019, the Arlington Heights Police Department completed a background check on Tommy Chanthabandith, who has 100% ownership interest in the business entity. No issues were noted.

A walk-thru of the restaurant was conducted on August 27 and the layout is consistent with the submitted floor plan.

Upon a satisfactory liquor interview, it would be appropriate to approve the issuance of a Class "E" liquor license to Triple 8, Corp. dba Gumrai Thai Restaurant located at 170 N. Arlington Heights Rd.
