I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Arlington Heights Youth Commission was called to order by Chair Dyer at 6:05pm in the Commissions Room at Village Hall.

III. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

A motion was made by Commissioner Guerra to approve the April 9, 2015 minutes and seconded by Commissioner Turchik. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

IV. REPORTS

Chair Dyer introduced herself to the new Youth Commissioner, Matt Healy from the Park District and welcomed him.

Park District – Commissioner Healy said that two pools will open Memorial Day weekend and the rest by June 5, 2015. Picnic in the Park is scheduled for June 5th at North School Park and will be held from 4:30pm-7:30pm - a change this year as this event was previously held during the day. He also stated Arlington Lakes Golf Course closes June 7, 2015 and will be closed for a year.

School District – The Commissioners discussed the PARCC testing and the option of opting out of tests.

Arlington Heights Memorial Library – Commissioner Spicer reminded everyone that the 9th Annual Film Fest is Friday, August 21, 2015. He also reminded everyone about the finals lounge at the Hub. There are summer volunteer opportunities at the library “Summer Volunteer Squads” with 12 different squads.

Police Department – Commander Hayes reported that there were five teens who presented in front of Peer Jury, two returning that met requirements and three new cases.

Future Campaigns/Activities – The Commissioner talked about different campaigns/activities that they could be involved in when not busy with the Teen Job Fair. Chair Dyer really would like to see the “Jaws of Life” return to the schools. Commander Hayes stated that he thought these were sponsored by AIM, or MADD. Chair Dyer will research.
