PROMENADE OF ART

The Arts Commission finalized details for participation in the Promenade of Art festival on June 9 and 10.

DECORATED OBJECT COMPETITION

The Arts Commission finalized details for the decorated lamp competition which is held as part of Frontier Days on Sunday July 1. The Commission discussed prizes for the event. The Commission discussed having gift cards from the two frozen yogurt shops in the Downtown. Commissioner Higgins-Thrash commented that she will pick up the ribbons.

FALL ART OUTREACH

Arts Chair Souter asked if there is any update regarding the Fall Outreach. Commissioner Neacy commented that there is no update at this time.

IDEA AND PROGRAM LIST

The Commission reviewed the updated program list. The Commission discussed ideas for future projects. Arts Chair Souter commented that one idea for a spring outreach event is a jazz fest. The Commission discussed the banner pole project. Staff Liaison Derek Mach provided background information regarding different banner programs that the Commission has held in the past. Staff Liaison Derek Mach commented that the project would most likely move forward next year. Commissioner Neacy suggested having a retro perspective of banners featured as part of a

temporary exhibit. Commissioner Walsh commented that Evanston's public works hosts a painted snowplow program and that students paint the plows.
