A. Community Survey

Commissioner Jordan shared the latest version of the resident survey she and Youth Commissioner Neacy had written after receiving input from the other members of the Commission. She said the results would be helpful for demonstrating to the Village Board which programs or regulations were supported by the public, and focus the goals for the Commission. Youth Commissioner Neacy asked when the survey should be released. The consensus was early spring of this year.
