ARTS OUTREACH EVENT

- A culinary program in conjunction with local restaurants
- Song writing competition
- Poetry program
- Projection mapping light show in the Downtown that possibly features the Village's new rebranding program
- Program related to the visual aspect and music as it relates to video games
- Feature or explore art as part of social media

Commissioner Cutlip commented that world art day is April 15. Staff Liaison Derek Mach suggested that the Commission continue to brainstorm ideas and narrow the list to few projects that could be further explored.
