I. Call to Order

III. Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Jordan moved to approve the minutes of the October 10, 2022, Environmental Commission meeting. Commissioner Jaeschke seconded the Motion. The Motion passed unanimously.

V. Old Business

A. Community Survey

Commissioner Jordan discussed the survey summary report she had written with assistance from Commissioner Skrudland. She read the executive summary. There was a discussion about increasing participation in programs such as curbside composting for residents by increasing publicity and information available. The report had recommended actions broken into categories that the Commission would work on and which Staff or the Village Board would work on. The report also included a recommendation that the Village hire a sustainability coordinator and increase publicity, such as more information about Tree City USA on the website.

Commissioner Jordan agreed to make the changes and forward the report to the Liaison. Commissioner Sawyer said it should be then forwarded to the Village Manager.

Commissioner Skrudland asked how the Village Board would receive copies and was told the Village Manager could provide copies for them. Commissioner Jaeschke said he wanted to receive responses from the Board. Chair O'Brien suggested the Commission discuss the report at a Committee-of-the Whole meeting for immediate feedback.

Commissioner Jordan moved to approve the survey report, as amended, and forward it to the Village Board for their review. Commissioner Sawyer seconded the Motion. The Motion passed unanimously.
