SUBJECT: Liquor License Interview: Timios Enterprises Corp., Palm Court
Restaurant and Banquets

At the Committee-of-the-Whole meeting on January 7, representatives of Timios Enterprises Corp dba Palm Court Restaurant and Banquets will be interviewed for consideration of a full-service "Class "AA" liquor license to this establishment located at 1912 N. Arlington Heights Road.

Liquor Classification:	Class "AA" license permits the retail sale, in restaurants only, of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises where sold and have a seating capacity at tables for a minimum of 75 persons for food service.
Establishment Liquor Hours:	Mon - Thur: 11am – 10pm; Fri: 11am – 11pm; Sat: 11am – 12am; Sun: 12pm – 9pm
Lease or Ownership:	Owns property and business
Basset Certification:	Yes
Address Violations:	Yes by previous owner: 2002, 2011, 2016
Applicant Liquor Sales Related Violations:	None

In December 2018 the Arlington Heights Police Department completed a background check on George Theodosopoulos. Mr. Theodosopoulos has 100% ownership interest in the business entity. No issues were noted.

A walk-thru of the restaurant was conducted on 12/31/18 and the layout is consistent with the submitted floor plans.

Upon a satisfactory liquor interview, it would be appropriate to approve the issuance of a Class "AA" to Timios Enterprises Corp dba Palm Court Restaurant and Banquets located at 1912 N. Arlington Heights Road. Liquor License will be issued upon surrender of current liquor license issued to this address.
