Transportation Report

Commissioner Feldman said he was prepared to discuss the letter to the mayor requesting approval to advocate for an expansion of weekend service for Pace, however, he left early due to the storms. Liaison Colagrossi advised that the discussion was tabled due to the incoming inclement weather.

Commissioner Feldman added that Pace did not have a board meeting in July and were scheduled to meet the day after the present meeting. He will have more to report on then.

Housing Report

Commissioner Motto discussed the affordable housing project from Full Circle, Grace Terrace. The Board will vote at August 19th meeting to vote to either deny the project, continue discussion, or to direct staff to prepare final approval ordinances for consideration at a later date. The procedural vote only requires a simple majority.

Commissioner Motto summarized the presentation from Sue Lollebach on "Affordable Housing 101". He added that Commissioner Raminiak presented a letter to be reviewed at the regular commission meeting on August 19 at 7 PM. Commissioner Motto stressed that affordable housing is not just an Age-Friendly issue, but an issue for everyone in the community, as affordable housing affects all ages.
