III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

COMMISSIONER WILLIAMS, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER WEBER, MOVED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES FROM THE AUGUST 19, 2019 MEETING. ALL CONCURRED AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

IV. REPORTS

A. Chairperson

Chairperson Feldman reported he had nothing new to report, other than legislation, further down the agenda.

B. Senior Center Manager

The Senior Center Manager provided an update on the Senior Center. She covered Medicare open enrollment appointments.

C. Senior Impacts Report

1. Not for Profit Corporation

The Senior Center Manager reported on the upcoming November 6 Senior Services Expo, Commissioners would receive a digital copy that they could forward to help Arlington Heights Senior Center, Inc. promote it.

2. Senior Center Advisory Council

The Senior Center Manager reported that the Advisory Council had finished holiday plans.

3. Legislation

Chairperson Feldman reported on August 23 HB833 became Public Act 101-043, effective immediately. In Illinois counties of 3,000,000 or more inhabitants, for the taxable years 2020-2024, a taxpayer who has been granted a Senior Citizens Homestead Exemption need not reapply. Currently, taxpayers must reapply annually. If the property ceases to be qualified for the exemption in any year when reapplication was not required, the owner of the property should notify the county assessor that the property is no longer qualified. The assessor shall enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the county clerk, department of public health and other appropriate governmental agencies to obtain information that documents the death of the taxpayer who has been granted senior citizens homestead exemption. This makes conforming changes regarding erroneous homestead exemptions.

4. Age Friendly Community Certification

Commissioner Motto reported that this project was gaining traction. He outlined that the survey link would be on the Village of Arlington Heights' website. The Senior Center Manager reported that it might be publicized by the library and that the park district would be asked. She outlined that it was hoped that there was the potential to have the Kiwanis assist people at the Senior Center on October 26 and suggested that perhaps the Senior Commission could assist people on November 2, the following Saturday. Commissioner Ramsey suggested having those who are filling out by paper do so on a Scantron sheet.
