The 2025 Senior Center Impact report was reviewed.

The liaison reported on the Senior Center Remodel workgroup meeting two weeks ago to review the 2022 Report submitted by BKV Architects. Many aspects of the project need to be reviewed and affirmed. The tentative target for this project would be in 2029.

A student from Hersey High School interviewed participants at the Senior Center and created a testimonial video. Ms. Colagrossi will share the video with the commission when it is completed.

The subcommittee discussed the different demographics of patrons that attend the Senior Center, such as how many lived outside of Arlington Heights, how many people are older adults in Arlington Heights, etc. Ms. Colagrossi will have a deeper dive into these numbers soon.

Liaison Colagrossi shared with the subcommittee that the website will undergo a revamp soon. The Senior Center is the thirteenth most searched item next to events on the Village's website.

The Senior Center division is working with community partners and the foundation to coordinate an events calendar for 2026.
