Affordable Housing

Commissioner Motto reported on Full Circle Grace Terrace has modified the plans, so no variances are required, and it is going back to the planning commission. The Planning Commission, Wednesday July 24th in the Arlington Collard board room. Commissioner Motto coordinated the Joining Forces Home Connect agency to conduct an Affordable Housing 101, informational Session. Sue Lollebach will present about the different types of affordable housing at the Senior Citizens Commission meeting at 7 pm on July 15 in the Commissions room. The goal is to understand that affordable housing is different for different people, and that communities should have a diverse range of housing for everyone in the community to live. It is more than subsidized homes for the disabled and older adults.
